Players Charter

In addition to the Laws of Cricket, the Corsham Cricket Club constitution and code of conduct, the West of England Premier League and Wiltshire County Cricket League regulations, all players should bear in mind the following:-

- Players must remember that they are representatives of Corsham Cricket Club and as such must maintain good standards on and off the field. A high degree of loyalty to and support of the Club is expected.
- Players should be punctual at arriving at published meet times. The meet time for each match will be notified in advance of the game by the team manager/captain, either on the club notice board, or by text message.
- Players will be expected to wear appropriate designated Club clothing on match days from the appointed meet time until leaving the Club premises to go home. Designated clothing includes Corsham CC casual wear (polo shirt, sweatshirt, 'hoody'), training kit, tracksuit, playing shirt and pullover.
- Players are expected to confirm availability for selection for the following week's matches by 6pm on Monday evenings. Availability will be indicated using the sheets on the notice board, or by notifying the team manager, or on the corsham.play-cricket.com website. Failure to do so could result in non-selection.
- Once selected teams are published, players must confirm their selection by no later than Thursday evening at 8pm either by initialling their name on the team selection sheet on the notice board, by informing the team manager, or by responding to the play-cricket website notification. Failure to do so could mean removal from the team for which they were selected.
- Players must make every effort to undertake other nominated duties such as providing someone to supply teas, and providing transport. Any player unable to carry out these duties should advise the team manager as soon as possible, and at the very latest by 8pm on the Thursday evening immediately prior to the match in question.
- Players must advise their team captain or write on the notice board one hour prior to leaving the meeting point, if they are making their own way to a fixture. Failure to do so could result in a loss of expenses.
- Players must respect the captain's decisions on and off the field. They must also respect the players and supporters of the opposition and the match officials. Any serious breach of conduct, will result in disciplinary action which will be carried out in line with the club constitution and disciplinary procedures.
- Any player found indulging or suspected of indulging in the supply or consumption of any banned substances whilst representing the Club will be immediately suspended from Corsham Cricket Club until further notice.
- Players are expected to regularly attend organised practice and training sessions without exception. Team captains should be notified in advance if a player is unable to attend for a valid reason. The selection committee will take account of regular attendees when selecting teams.
